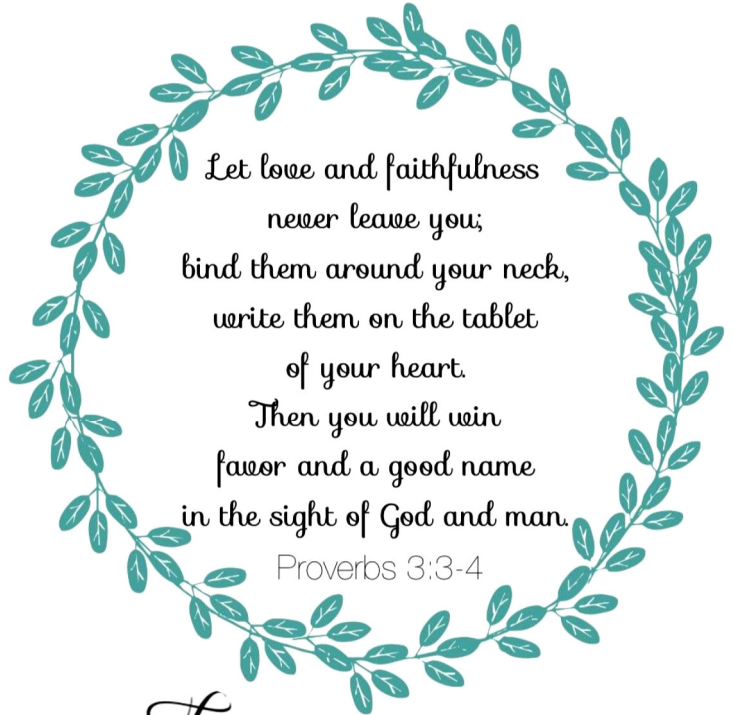

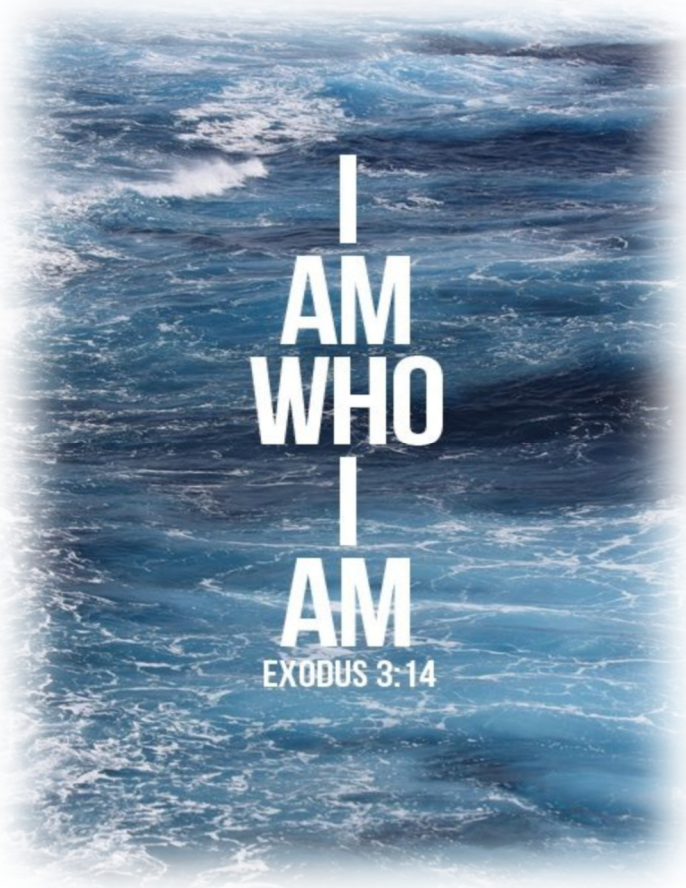
God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM.

This is my name forever, the name by which I am to be remembered from generation to generation.

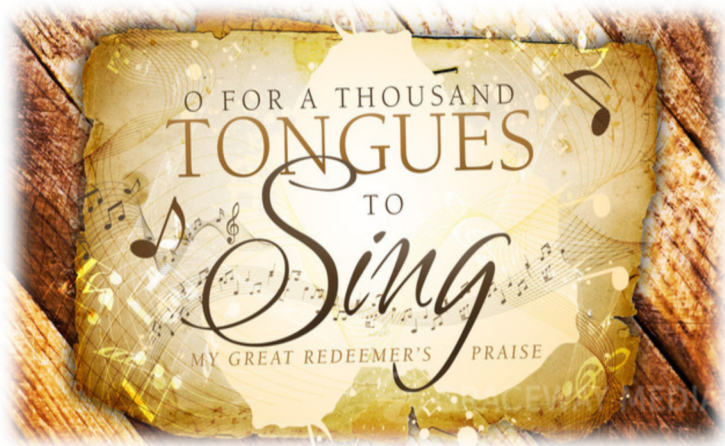
